Candidates will access their Clinical Practice Placement via their AMS Dashboard to completed the Self-Assessment Requirement for their Video Progress Assessments.

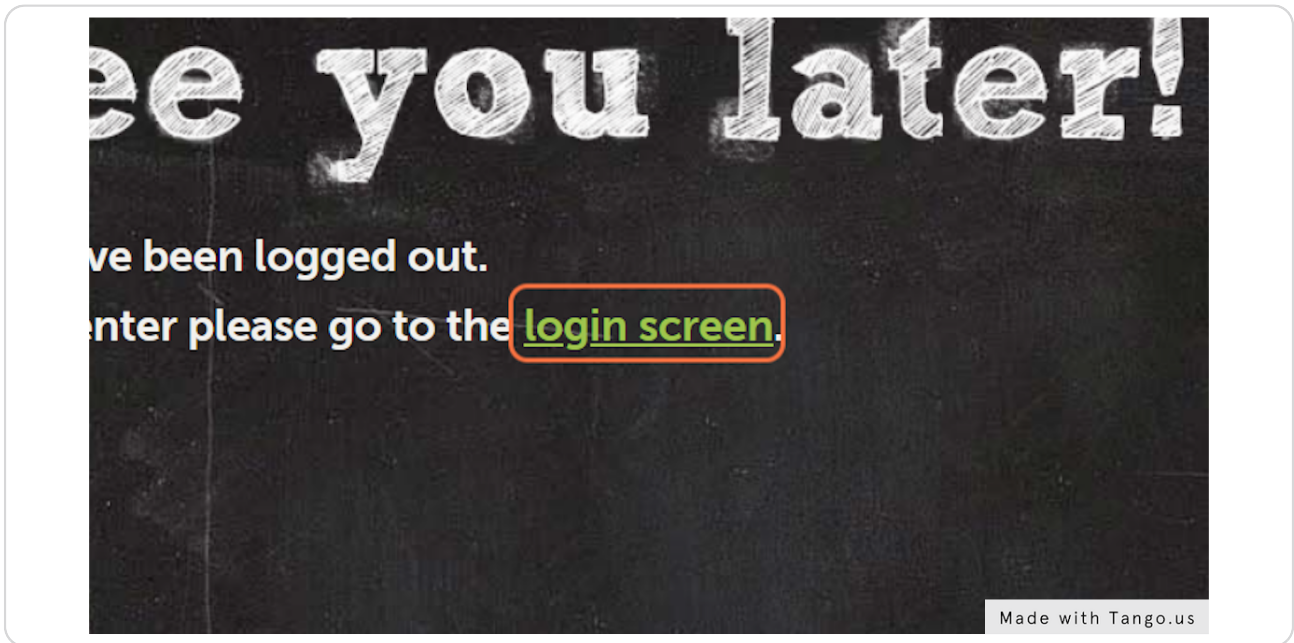

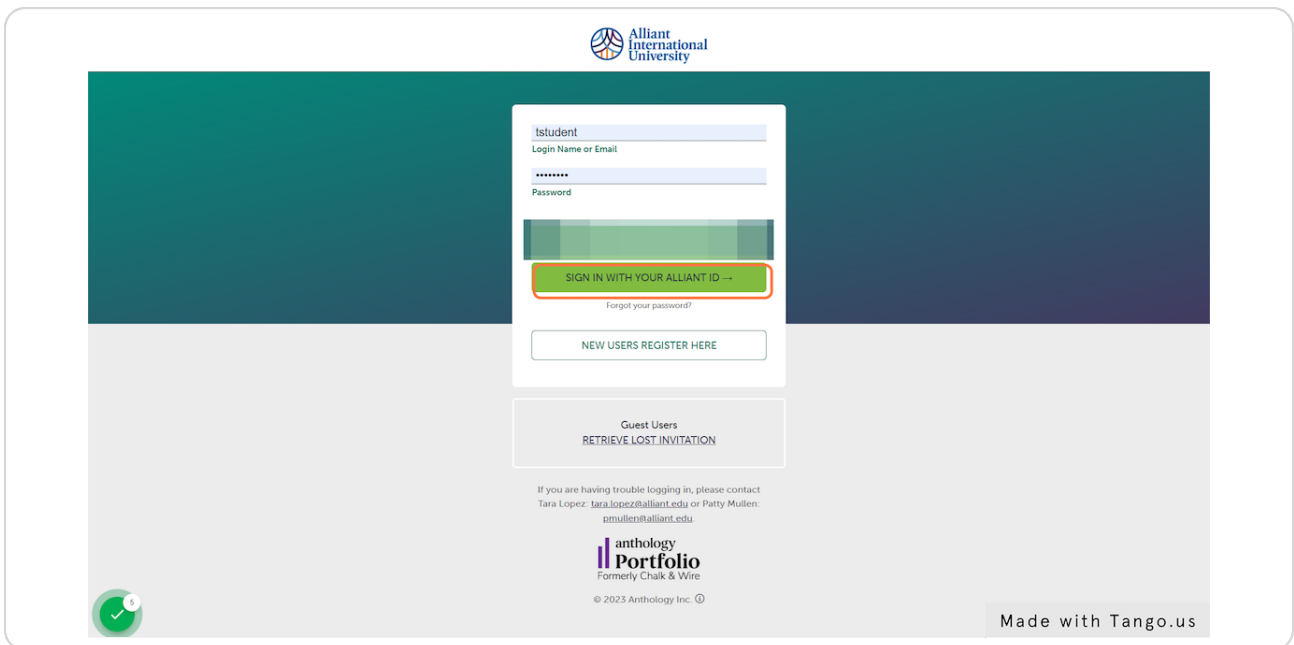

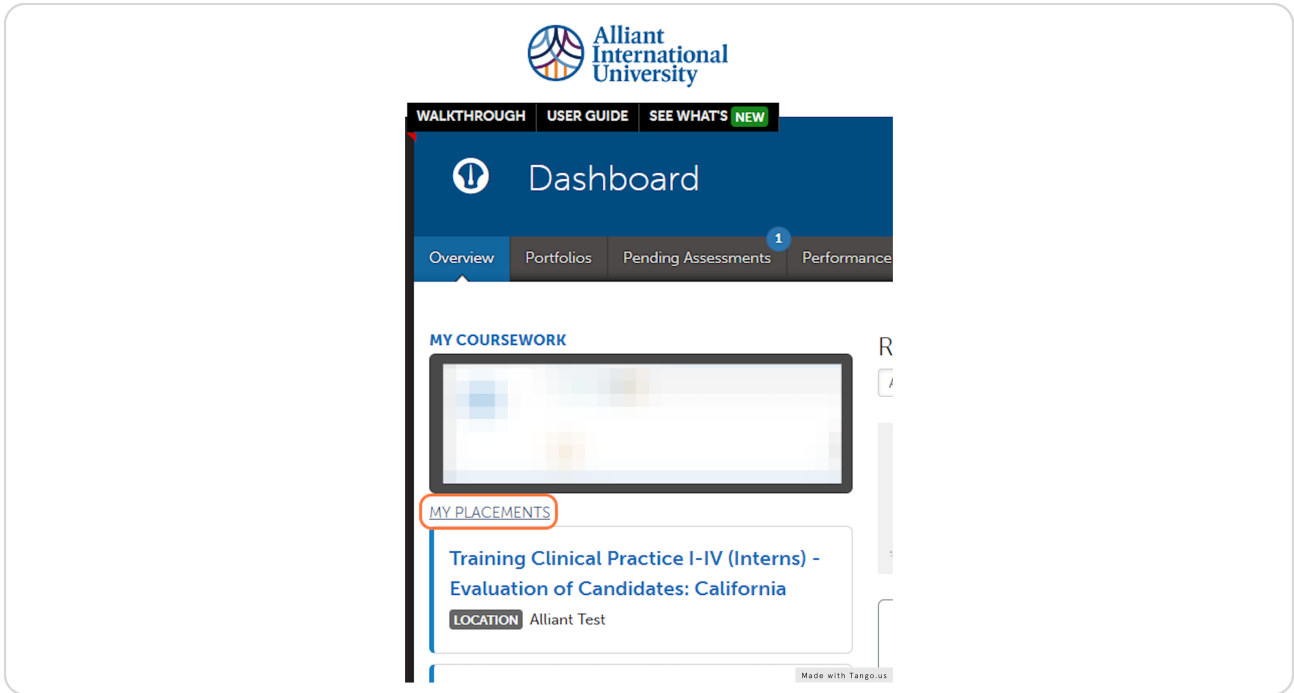
STEP 2

STEP 3

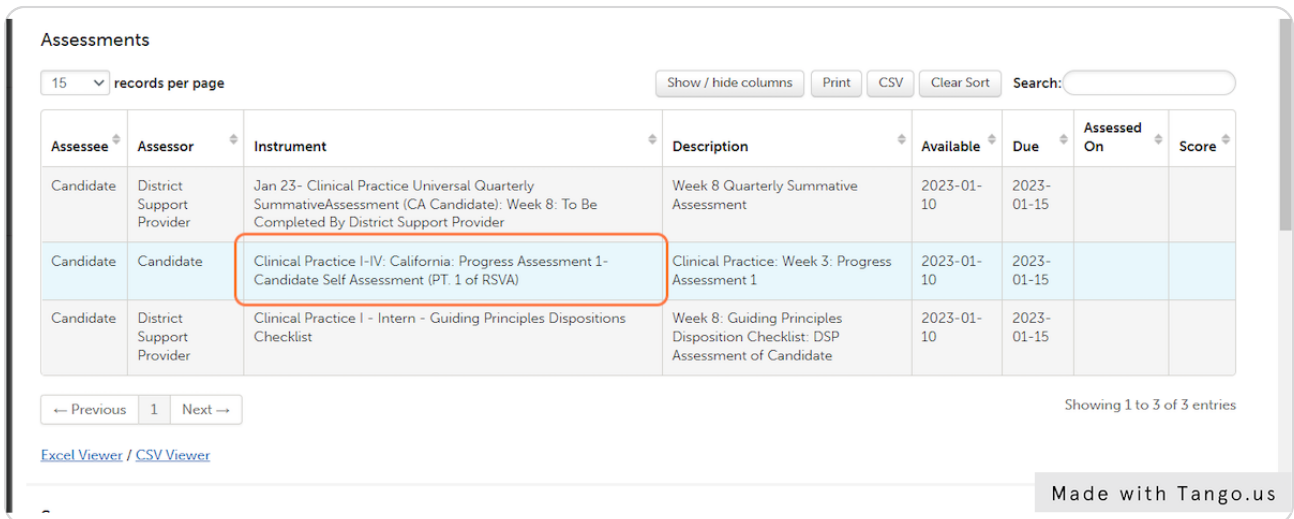
Click on MY PLACEMENTS




