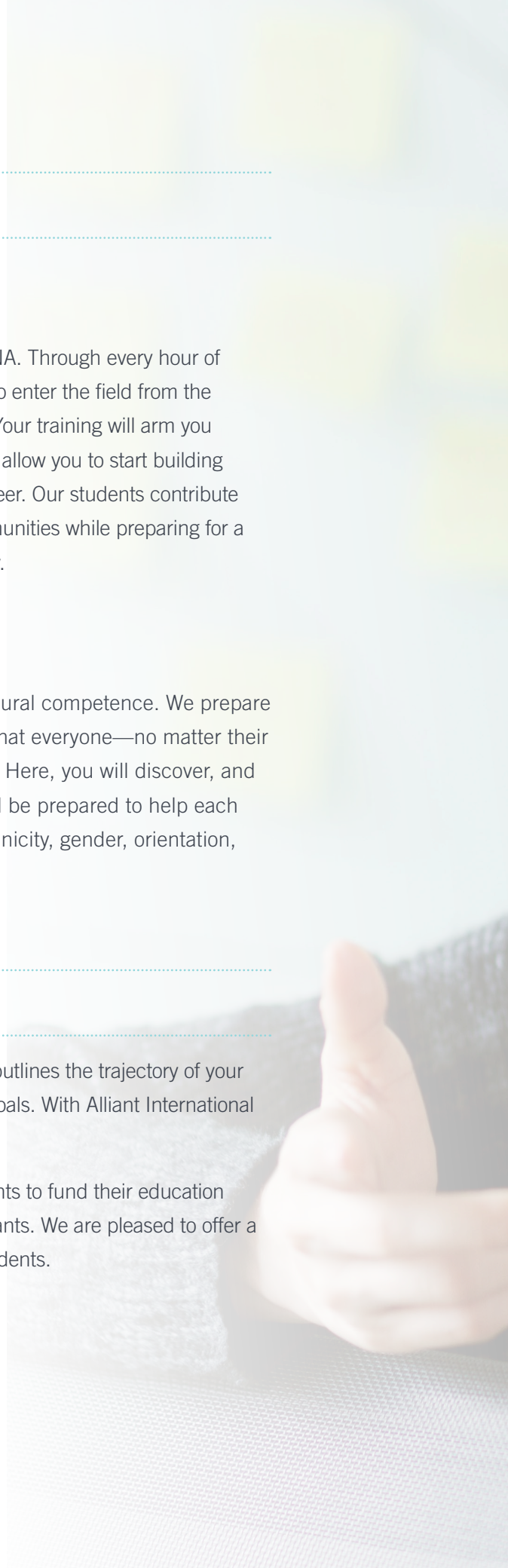
MULTICULTURAL APPROACH

MA in Clinical Counseling

Through practitioner-based coursework and specialized field practica, in our Master's in Clinical Counseling Degree Program you will develop skills to diagnose, treat, and proactively guide individuals and groups to overcome disability, grow, and embrace change. Upon graduation, you may be eligible to apply to the Board of Behavioral Science for a two-year, 3,000-hour internship of supervised practice and take the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Examination in order to obtain Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC) licensure.
