



Intern Credential Program Preservice Requirement

The California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) requires all intern credential applicants (Multiple Subject, Single Subject, or Education Specialist) provide evidence of a minimum Preservice preparation program prior to recommendation for the intern credential. A candidate with a minimum two (2) years of experience as a teacher-of-record in a California school may use **verified district hours of training and professional practice** to demonstrate and document capacity and preparation in identified Preservice standards of preparation and to meet the Preservice requirement.
